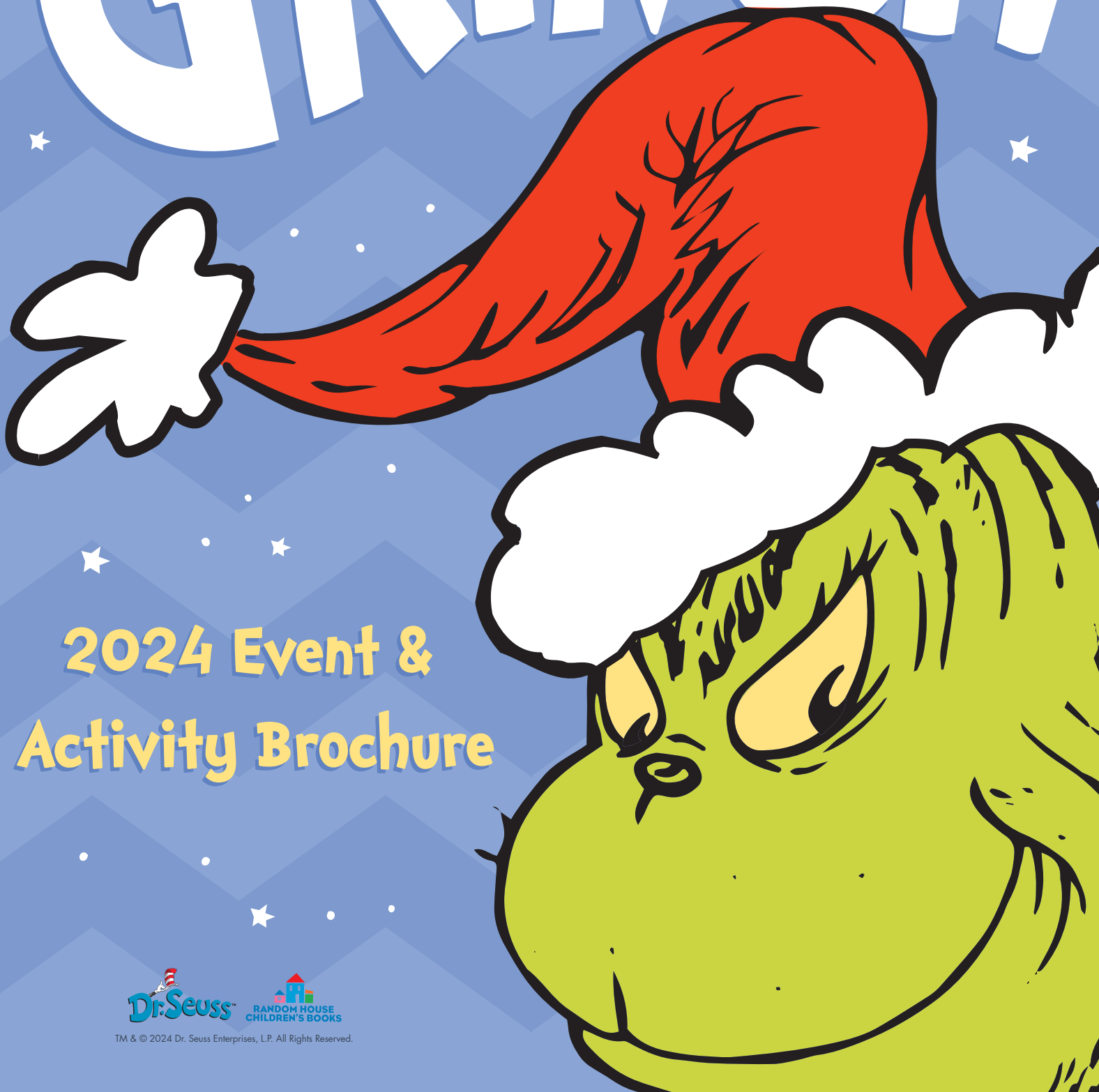

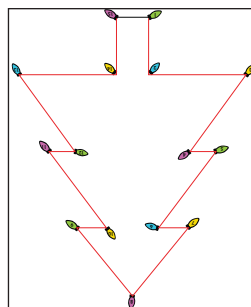

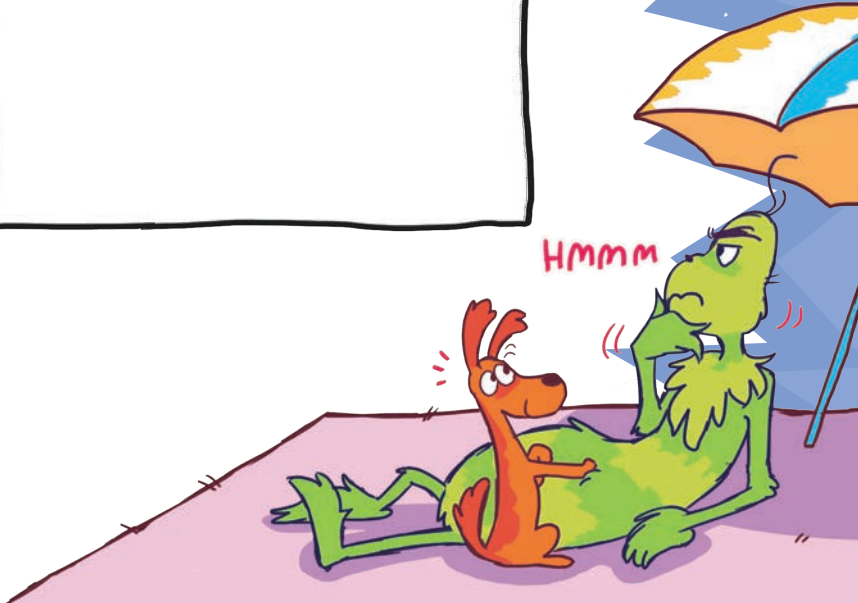
Grinchmas Vacation

LEGS, AND TAIL.



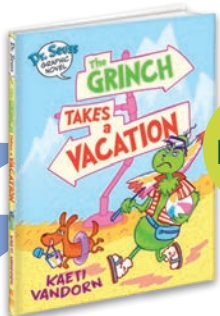
③ CONNECT YOUR LINES!

④ CLEAN UP AND COLOR!



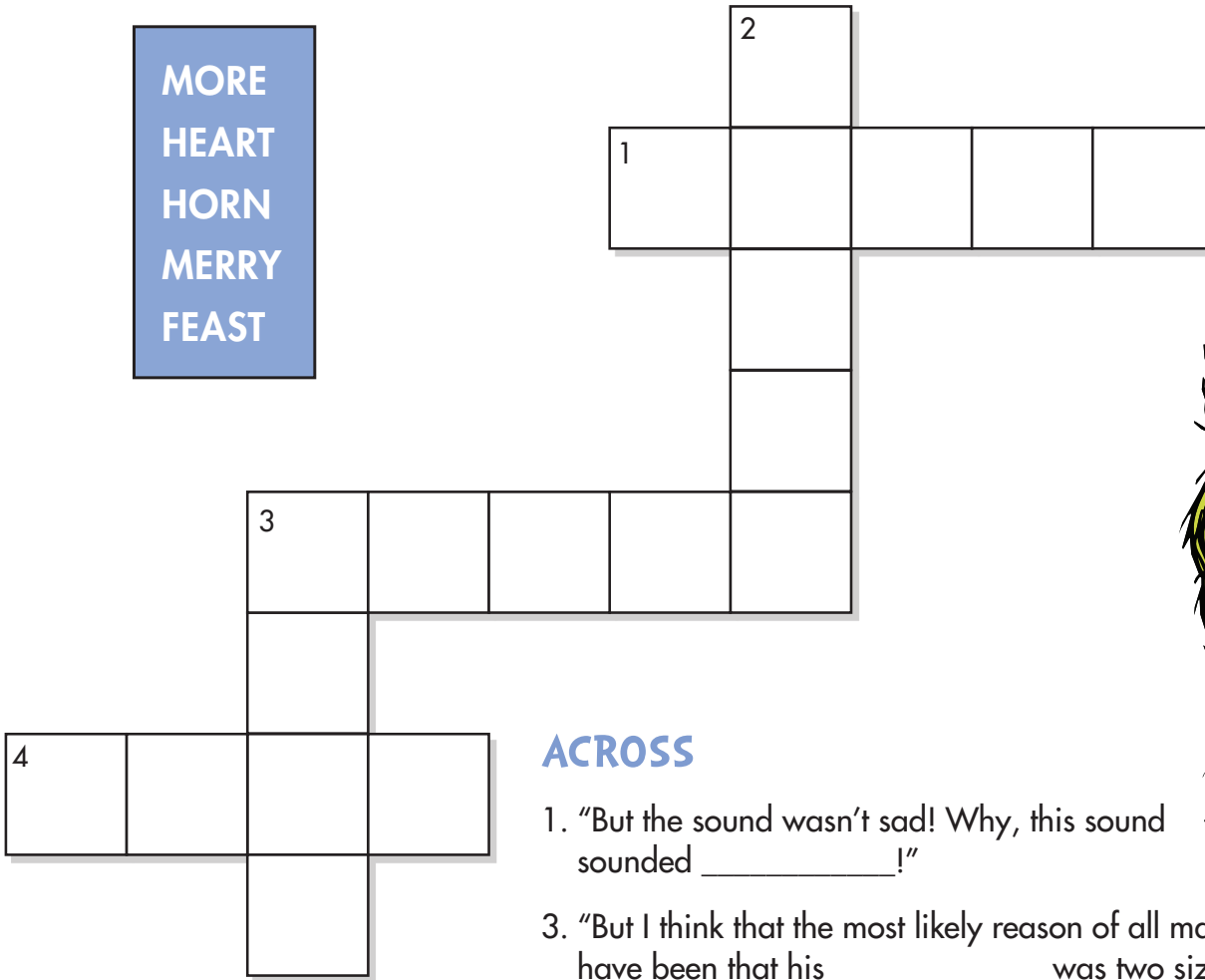
