

Fill in your reading goal in the circle on the left and track the books you read below. Use the star stickers provided to rate each book!



READING CHALLENGES

- 1. READ ALOUD: Read any Dr. Seuss book aloud to or with someone you love. Share the fun of Dr. Seuss's rhymes and illustrations together!
- 2. SEUSS NEWCOMER: Pick a Dr. Seuss book you have never read before. Discover a new favorite! Some suggestions are The 500 Hats of Bartholomew Cubbins, I Can Lick 30 Tigers Today and Other Stories, and Did I Ever Tell You How Lucky You Are.
- 3. RHYMING CHALLENGE: Choose a Dr. Seuss book with lots of rhymes. Pay attention to the rhyming words and see if you can come up with some of your own!
- 4. SEUSS ADVENTURE: Read a Dr. Seuss book that takes place in a fantastical setting, like Who-ville or the Jungle of Nool. Imagine you're there!
- 5. ILLUSTRATION FUN: Read the Dr. Seuss book that features your favorite illustrations, and create your own drawing inspired by them. Share your artwork with family and friends!
