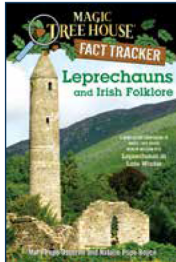
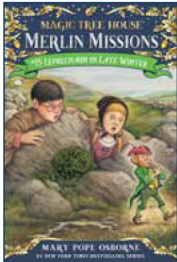
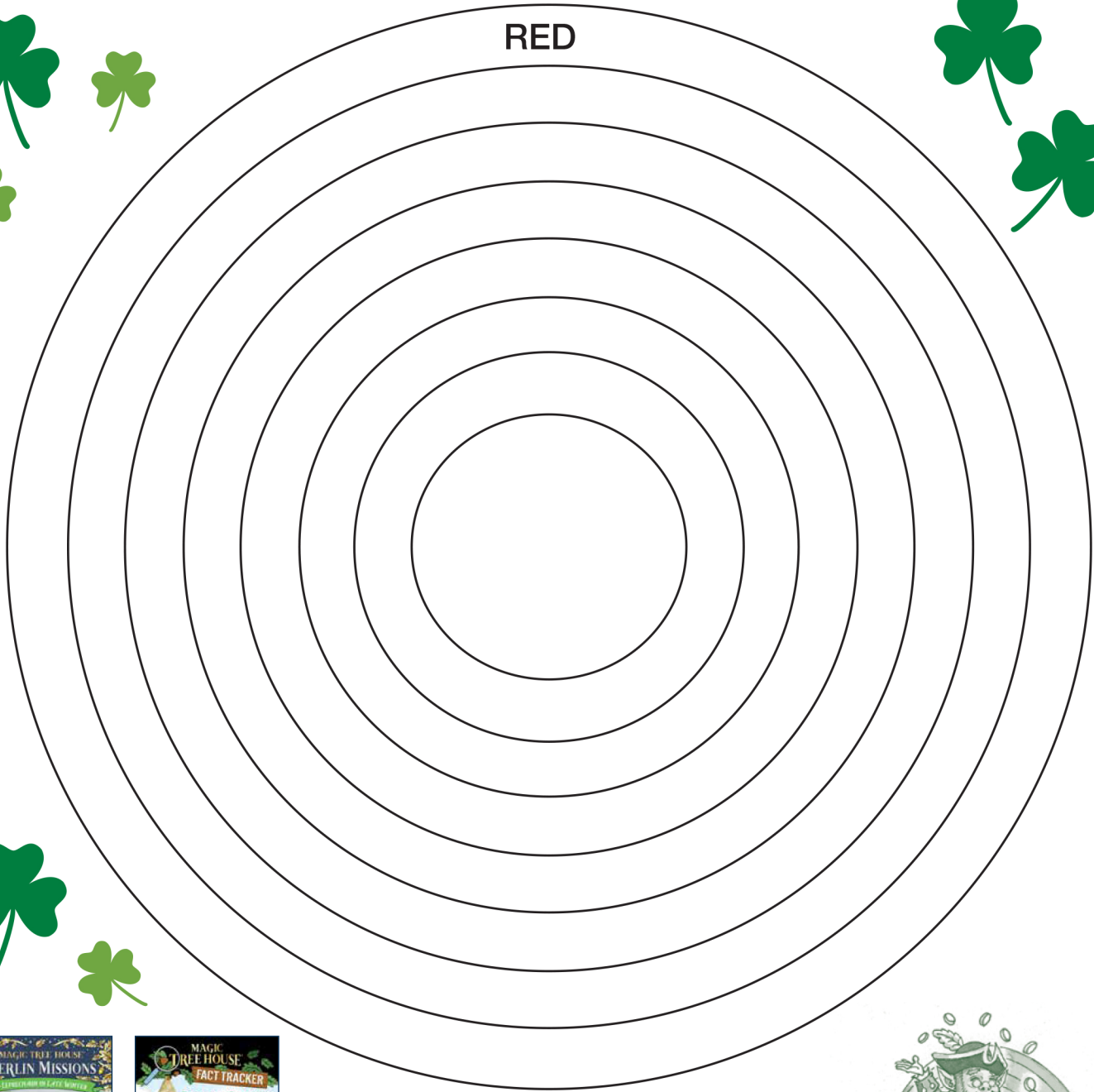


# ROUND IS A RAINBOW

Here's something to help you remember: ROY G. BIV




# BIG HOUSE, BIG CHORES!

# MERROW MAZE

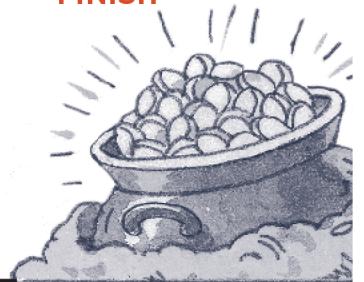

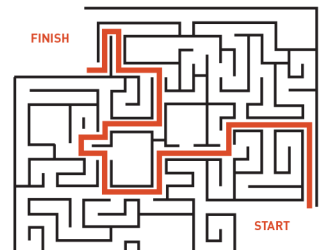
